

ATTENTION REGISTERED VOTERS OF MARION COUNTY

Effective June 1, 2017, the State of Missouri will require a photo identification in order to vote. The following forms of identification will be accepted at your polling location:

- Show a government issued photo identification.
 - Driver License
 - Non Driver License
 - Passport
 - Military Identification
- Sign a statement which will be provided and show one of the following documents:
 - Voter Registration Card
 - Identification from a Missouri University, College, Vocational or Technical School.
 - Utility Bill
 - Bank Statement
 - Government Check
 - Payroll Check
 - Other Government Document showing your name and address.
- Vote a provisional ballot (There are two ways your vote will count).
 - If your signature matches the signature in the voter registry, your vote will count.
 - If you come back to your polling place and show a photo identification, your vote will count.

If you do not have a photo identification to vote and already possess the necessary documents to obtain a non-driver license, please visit your local license office and request a free non-driver license for voting purposes. You can visit www.dor.mo.gov to find the nearest license office.

To obtain a non-driver license from the Missouri Department of Revenue, you will need to provide the following documentation:

- Proof of Name, Date of Birth, Place of Birth
 - U.S. Birth Certificate OR U.S. Passport OR U.S. Certificate of Citizenship, Naturalization or Birth Abroad OR a photocopy of a certified U.S. Birth Certificate accompanied by a U.S. Military Identification Card OR U.S. Military Discharge Papers.
- Social Security Number (verbally or by presenting card)
- Proof of Missouri Residential Address
 - Utility Bill
 - Payroll Check
 - Government Check
 - Mortgage Document
 - Voter Identification Card
 - Property Tax Receipt
 - Housing Rental Contract
 - Bank Statement

If you want a photo ID to vote and do not have one, the Missouri Secretary of State's Office will help you obtain a non-driver license for free. You may need a copy of either a certified birth certificate, a certified marriage license, a certified divorce decree, a certified adoption paper or an amended birth certificate, a court order that changed your name, a social security card that reflects your name, or naturalization papers that prove citizenship.
