PROPOSITION K.I.D.S.

Shall the Board of Education of the Monroe City R-1 School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Six Million Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$6,700,000) for the purpose of providing funds for the site development, construction, equipping, and furnishing of the south wing of the Elementary School addition to include classrooms, hallways, and restrooms; to the extent funds are available, the renovation of the existing Elementary School with a potential multi-purpose room and the completion of other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.9900 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
